During 2009 PIEp has tested a concept for increasing co-publication between its different disciplines and nodes. The concept, Tiger Team Writing Workshops, was successful and had the intended result of a large number of conference papers at ICED'09. We would now like to proceed with this concept and invite you to a series of workshops focused on scientific journal publication.

As a research student *or* researcher within the PIEp network you are welcome to participate, free of charge, in a series of three workshops during spring 2010, with the purpose of developing your own publication strategy. During the two first workshops lectures on journal publication will be given and discussions held on journals and strategies for publication. Our intention is also that every participant writes a paper during this period for submission (and feedback) in advance of the third workshop.

Thus, knowledge and inspiration for journal publishing together with a process for paper writing will be provided.

WORKSHOP 1

Wednesday 13th January, 10-16, KTH

- Mats Magnusson: Strategies for publication, selection of journals, paper design, the writing and review process, co-publishing;
- Participants present their paper ideas.

WORKSHOP 2

Tuesday 9th February, 10-16, LTH

- Guest speakers Mats Leijon, Uppsala University and Harry Boer, Aalborg University (tbc): Long experiences from journal publishing, strategies, tactics and advice;
- Participants present their paper concepts and choice of journal.

Deliver paper by email, for review by the Journal Writing Journey Group.

WORKSHOP 3

Thursday 19th August, 10-16, KTH

- Participants' presentations of their papers, how feedback was handled and discussion of personal strategies for journal publication.
